My wife and I have just returned from a nine day trip to Transylvania where we were honored to be members of a tour led by Mr. Stefano Ionescu the world famous author of '*Antique Ottoman Rugs in Transylvania*' and world recognized authority in Transylvanian carpets. The trip was also joined by Mr. Alberto Boralevi, well known rug scholar, rug dealer and big shot with the ICOC. We had the opportunity to view approximately four hundred 15th century to 18th century Transylvania rugs in Saxon Lutheran churches, private collections and museums. This total probably represents half of this type of rug in the world.

Mr. Ionescu is unbelievably charming and extremely well versed in the country of his birth. He provided 1st class lodging and excellent meals for the twenty or so people in the trip. Probably half of the group came to see the architecture and the churches which was fine with me as it gave me more time to look at the rugs.
